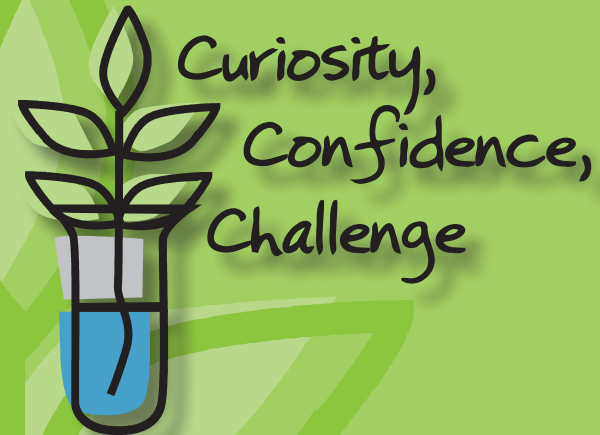

*This conference may open the door to a world of career opportunities!*

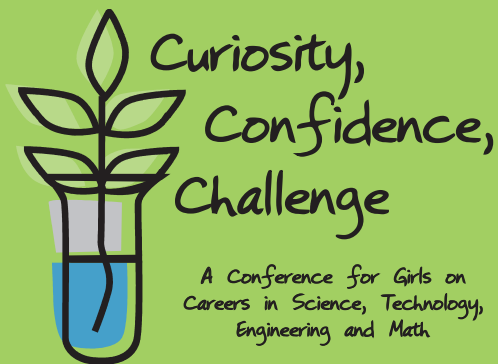
**Participants:** Girls in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades.
