An advance tuition deposit of \$600, which is applied to annual tuition, is required at the time of initial enrollment as well as part of the Continuous Enrollment process in February for each subsequent school year.

Payment Plans	
Sycamore School uses Blackbaud Tuition Management for billing and payment of all school-related fees. Payment of tuition and other fees will be based on each family's choice of the 2-Pay Plan or the 10-Pay Plan through Blackbaud Tuition Management. All payments are due on the first day of the month per the following schedule:	
2-Pay Plan — Equal payments on July 1 and January 1	
10-Pay Plan ** — Equal payments July 1 - April 1
